

Additional Follow up ideas:

1. Invite people to a discussion (non-preaching) about something illustrated in the picture.
 - a. Have a student lead the discussion
 - b. Discussion should include space to respond to the story artistically; possibly share the response with the group
2. Invite to a GIG that go through each of the healing stories on the Story Project Mural.
 - a. Give them space to respond to each GIG artistically and share it with the group.
3. Ask if they have a recital or an art Show coming up that you can attend.
4. Invite key IV arts leaders to go with you to their event
5. Invite them to share some of their art with you and the stories that inspired the piece
 - a. Ask if you can visit their studio
 - b. Ask if they would be interested in collaborating on a story piece
6. Host an arts dinner where they bring a piece of their art to share with each other
7. Create their own mural party
8. Host a time to create and perform art around these stories (open mic night?)
 - a. A collaborative/improv event that includes the mural and different artists taking turns playing, singing, or doing spoken work around it
 - b. Have an open canvas available for people to reflect their experience or to create their own mural reflecting the campus
